

### DSBF \$100,000 Pacing Finals-Monday, April 6th

**Mr Wiggles** was a 6-1 surprise winner of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) \$100,000 3-Year-Old Colt Final when Corey Callahan drove the colt past public choice **Ray's Big Bubba**, driven by Ross Wolfenden of Felton, for a 1:52 victory. The win was the second in three races this year and seventh in 11 lifetime starts for **Mr Wiggles**, owned by Elmer Fannin of Lincoln and George Teague, Jr. Inc. of Harrington. A second place finish snapped a three-race win streak for **Ray's Big Bubba**. **Al Ibad Spider** and Eric Goodell took third money.

Eric Goodell drove **Little Bit Tricky** to a 1:54.2 photo finish victory in the \$100,000 DSBF soph filly pace, edging **Honey** and George Dennis and pacesetting **Rusty's Joy**, who led from the start for Eddie Davis, Jr. Josh Green trains the filly who has two wins this season and six in 11 career races for Jim and Brent Outten and Green Racing Inc. of Milford.

Both winners were sired by the Winbak of DE, Inc. stallion, **Badlands Hanover**.

### DSBF \$100,000 Trotting Finals-Wednesday, April 8th

**Dover, DE -- TP Lucy** and **Ruby Ransom** were decisive winners of \$100,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) finals Wednesday (April 8) at Dover Downs.

Tony Morgan led off a banner night of racing with the first of four winning drives piloting Mark Waterman's **TP Lucy** to a 1:58.1 victory, her second straight and fourth in five career races in the \$100,000 DSBF 3-Year-Old Filly Trot final.

The Linbo-Fastreena chestnut was an easy winner reducing her lifetime record by one full second. **TP Lucy** has now won \$73,500 in her five races, and is the fastest of 14 registered foals by Linbo, a Lindy Lane stallion owned by

**Ruby Ransom** rushed into the lead just past the opening quarter pole and then was never headed in a 1:58.3 conquest in the \$100,000 3-Year-Old Colt Trot final. Brandon Givens of Seaford was the winning pilot, driving for Ed Maas and Nanticoke Racing Inc. of Seaford. The win was the second, with two seconds, in four starts this season for the CR Commando-Dreamland's Trophy colt that has been 1-2-3 in 16 of 19 career starts while banking \$211,304 in two seasons of racing. **Ruby Ransom** was bred and sold by Winbak of DE, Inc.
